OVERVIEW: Following the great success of CHINACOM'06 and CHINACOM'07, CHINACOM'08 will be held in Hangzhou, China, one of the most beautiful cities in the world, on Aug. 25-27 2008, right after the 2008 Beijing Olympic Games.
